

Making the most of your Eye-Catcher products

Eye-Catcher products can dramatically reduce your safety sign costs and increase your flexibility to respond to new safety hazards. Our sign holders let you print your own signs and avoid the expense of vinyl, paint or laminating. Here are a few practical suggestions to help you to make the most of our products.

Paper Selection

Standard 80GSM photocopy paper is sufficient for applications where signs are to be replaced regularly. Using 80GSM photocopy paper will cost as little as 3 cents for each sign. We recommend that you use a higher quality paper if your signs are not likely to be replaced on a regular basis.

Printing

It has been our experience that laser printers provide the best results for outdoor signs. Most inks used in inkjet printers will fade over time therefore we recommend regular replacement of signs (every 2 months minimum). We recommend the use of brand name ink rather than cheap generic refills.

Cleaning & Maintenance

Like any product used outdoors, Eye-Catcher sign holders will require cleaning from time to time. We recommend cleaning the visual face of the sign holder with water and a soft cloth as required.

Replacement of Sign Holders

Eye-Catcher sign holders will eventually need replacement. The time to replacement depends on whether the products are used outdoors and how well the products are treated during use. We recommend replacement every three years in typical applications.
